The Graduate Certificate in Emergency Management Cybersecurity is a online certificate offered by the Department of Criminal Justice. The certificate designed to prepare decision makers to address the growing challenges of managing effective cybersecurity practices and mitigating threats within public and private organizations, including small businesses. The knowledge and skills gained in this certificate program are intended to be applied to interdisciplinary business practices with high regulatory frameworks. Students will learn to develop business continuity and recovery strategies that identify mission essential functions and time-critical tasks, and will understand legal ramifications relevant to cybersecurity. The program is designed for individuals who do not have technological backgrounds, but who must still prepare for, and respond to, the ever-present danger of cyber-attacks.

A current resume which should indicate professional experience in the field of policy making or IT management All the above should be submitted online through the Graduate College admissions application.
